**With soaring gas prices now is a great time to explore some Rideshare options!**

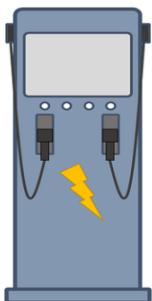
## Vanpool

The Los Angeles County Vanpool Subsidy Program provides \$650 for electric-powered vans and \$250 for gas-powered vans paid directly to the vendor. For more information, on starting a vanpool contact your Department's Employee Transportation Coordinator.



**Carpool** Two or more people in one car driving to and from work sharing at least 50 percent of the distance. Carpooling is a low-cost rideshare option. Depending on the vehicle make and model and location, a full tank of gas can be costing between \$80-\$120. Think of the amount you'd save simply by splitting the cost of commuting with other riders.

**Public Transportation** Riding the bus or taking the light rail is a cost effective commute option. Save on gasoline, maintenance, insurance, depreciation and taxes by taking public transportation. For current rates and schedule information, please visit [Metro.net](http://Metro.net)
